

JOPLIN FRESHMEN VOLLEYBALL TOURNAMENT

SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 19, 2020

1. The tournament will be played at Joplin High School, 2104 Indiana in two gyms.
2. Teams: Branson, Carl Junction, Carthage, Joplin, Kickapoo, McDonald County, Republic, Webb City.
3. Pool play will begin at 9:00am. Then we will follow the schedule that is attached.
Games will be played ahead of schedule, if possible.
4. Each team will have a regulation warm-up (5-6-1) before the first match, and a 3-minute warm-up before each following match.
5. Four registered officials will be employed for the tournament.
6. **Each team will be responsible for bringing one Adult line judge to be used in their matches.**
7. **Each team will be responsible for providing their own libero tracker.**
8. Warm-up balls will be provided.
9. There will be a concession stand. A hospitality room will be available for officials, coaches and administrators.
10. Coolers and any outside food will be permitted on the mezzanine in Kaminsky Gym. PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOURSELVES. Only water on the benches. Thank you.
11. Rally scoring will be used. Pool play will consist of 2 games to 25. Cap at 29. Each game will start at 4. The team listed first will be the home team on the scoreboard. (Exception: Joplin will always be home.) Championship play will be a regulation match.
12. Top two teams out of each pool will advance to championship Bracket play. This will be decided as follows: 1) most wins 2) head to head winner 3) points accumulated all during pool play 4) coin toss. 1st place in each pool will be the home team on the scoreboard during semifinals and the team coming from the Main Gym bracket will serve as the home team in the Championship game.
13. COVID-Spectator guidelines are below. Benches will be set up in a socially distanced fashion but each team may move chairs as they see fit. We will provide an ice water cooler on the bench but each team is responsible for bringing personal water containers.

Joplin Athletics Fall Event Attendance Policies



All Middle School and High School Sports with the Exception of Varsity Football

- Spectator occupancy at all events will be limited to 50% capacity of fixed seating areas.
- Spectators will be admitted to events on a first come, first serve basis.
- No re-entry will be permitted at single game contests.
 - Re-entry will be permitted at multi-team events in which teams may play at multiple times throughout the event.
- **All spectators should wear a face covering as they enter/exit the facility and at all times while unable to socially distance including using the restrooms or going to the concession stand. When you move, please mask.**
- Spectators in the bleachers should socially distance. Families may sit together but should maintain at least 6 feet of separation from other families.
- Lawn chairs/bag chairs are allowed in standing room only areas at outdoor events.
- Gatherings on the field and court prior to or after the game are not permitted.
